How to get to the BAIC Sod-Turning

- From the PORT ELIZABETH Airport.
- Follow the exit signs out of the airport complex to the STOP sign, then take a right.
- At the next intersection, turn right into Allister Miller Drive also marked M11 Walmer, (The Engen garage will be on your left).
- Follow this road until it becomes a T-junction with traffic lights, then turn left towards Walmer Boulevard Road.
- Follow this road up to a T-junction with traffic lights. Turn right into Heugh Road / Walmer Boulevard - also marked M9.
- Proceed through 2 sets of traffic lights, driving in the middle lane.
- Turn left at the Marine Drive intersection and follow the signs M4 Cape Town / Grahamstown for 6 kms.
- Take N2 direction to Grahamstown for 18 kms.
- Follow signs indicating Port of Ngqura / Coega Business Centre off-ramp from N2, follow direction signs onto Neptune Road and go under the N2.
- Follow direction signs to Port of Ngqura / Coega Business Centre.
- At the SPEED HUMPS, turn right towards the Coega Zone 1 entrance gates.
- Follow this road, trough the traffic circle and onwards for 1,5 kms towards Lwandle Road.
- Turn right at the Lwandle Road intersection.
- Take your first left to reach the BAIC Sod-Turning site (turn-off before reaching the brindge crossing over the N2).
